SPEAKER INFORMATION

Captain Larry Sonntag, is an 18 year veteran of the Albuquerque Police Department. He has worked in five field services bureaus and supervised numerous specialty units. He is currently the Scientific Evidence Division Commander, which includes the Crime Lab, Major Crime Scene Investigations, Identification Unit and the Evidence Unit. Captain Sonntag was promoted and assigned to command the APD Scientific Evidence Division at a time when the Evidence Unit was suffering from intense negative public scrutiny because of ongoing criminal investigations concerning the loss or theft of money, guns, drugs and other high value items.

Annette Peer, has been employed as a Criminalist with the San Diego Police Department since 1983. During the course of her criminalistics career, she has performed work in the areas of serology, trace evidence, drug analysis, crime scene reconstruction and served as a laboratory supervisor. She was also one of two analysts who started the DNA laboratory at the police department in 1992.

Dr. Laura Fulginiti, is a board-certified forensic anthropologist working in the Phoenix metropolitan area. She provides services to Medical Examiners, the National Park Service, the FBI and other agencies as necessary. She is qualified as an expert in both State and Federal courts. She provides training to law enforcement communities. Several of her cases have been profiled in books and on television.

Sgt. Ginger Charles, received her Doctorate in Health Psychology and has done research specializing in health stressors within the Police culture. Employed in Law Enforcement for 20 years, she is currently at Arvada Police Dept. where she supervises the Crisis Intervention Team, Field Training and the School Resource Program.
